

# Tobyhanna SP Ski Trip

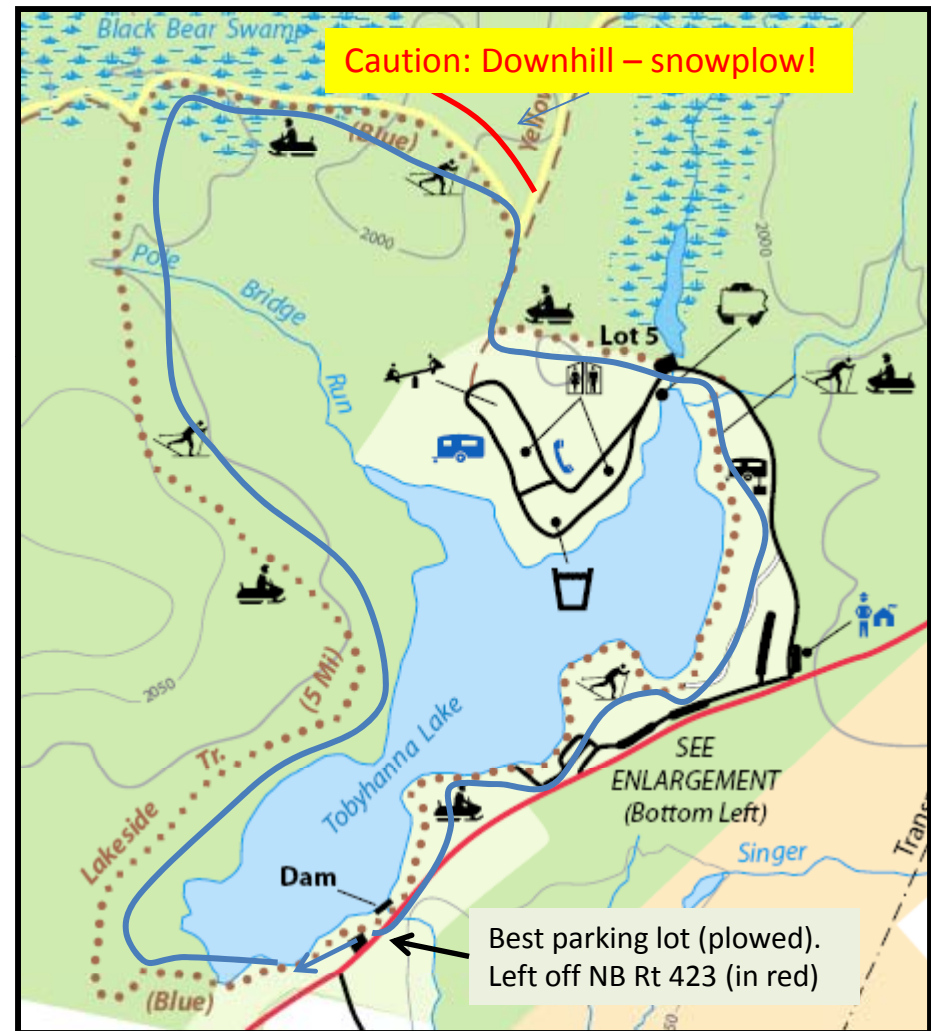

The 5.1 mile loop (blue) around Tobyhanna Lake is a nice day trip about 2 hours from Philadelphia. Conditions most of the winter are generally good even when there's little snow elsewhere in the Poconos. While it's a joint use trail with snowmobiles, skiers predominate – and you will often meet others on the trail. Take about 2 hours. Proceed from the lot onto a wooded trail maintained as a walking path in the summer. The only tricky spot is a slight downhill (marked in red) which can be snowplowed down. After the bridge, be sure to turn right along the lakeside trail and back to the lot.

Directions: Northeast PA TP extension to Pocono Exit; East on Rt. 940 through Blakeslee to Pocono Pines. Left at the light on Rt. 423 ~ 5 miles, cross Rt. 611, quick left and right following Rt. 423 to the first parking lot on the left – see map.
